PROGRAM OUTLINE

Monday, 19 August 2024

Cultural Tour (Bridge Climb & City Walk), approx. 9:30am to 4pm

We will spend time seeing the sights and some historical elements of Brisbane's River City. The day will commence with your choice of two options: the Story Bridge Climb or a walk through the city.

Bridge Climb: This part of the tour will take approx. 2 hours and will allow you to see Brisbane from the top of the city's most iconic structure, the Story Bridge. The climb is a guided walk (with a lot of stairs) with knowledgeable guides. The climb includes a safety demonstration, harness equipment and jumpsuit for the walk. Comfortable, enclosed, preferably rubber soled shoes (running/sport/hiking shoes) and comfortable clothing is encouraged.

City Walk: This part of the tour will see you explore Brisbane by foot with a route that includes Queen Street Mall, Parliament House, Qld University of Technology, Botanical Gardens and the famous RiverWalk, finishing up at Howard Smith Wharves.

Both groups will meet at the Howard Smith Wharves, where, after lunch, we will catch a river cat winding its way upstream. We will make a short visit to City Hall and its museum, and finish the tour with a stop at one of the city's oldest churches.

The educational tour will see visits to 2 member schools.

The journey will start with a bus trip to visit Mueller College, where we will tour their facilities and learn about their educational programs. We will depart the school and head back to the Sofitel hotel to arrive at approx 4pm.
